CLIMATE CHANGE

Cathay co-initiated the Hong Kong Sustainable Aviation Fuel Coalition to advance the development, supply and use of sustainable aviation fuel ("SAF"). We launched a landmark tripartite partnership in fostering Hong Kong's first SAF ecosystem. Globally, our Corporate SAF Programme achieved significant growth where programme partners altogether committed to using about 6,270 tonnes of SAF.

COMMUNITY

2024 marked the 20th anniversary of Cathay's flagship youth development programme, I Can Fly. We contributed around **6,000 hours** for different community initiatives as well as made charitable donations amounting to **HK\$5.1 million** in direct payments and a further **HK\$3.1 million** in the form of discounts on airline travel.





CIRCULAR ECONOMY

Cathay Pacific set two new secondary single-use plastics ("SUP") targets for 2025 – increasing inflight recycling of water bottles to **33%** and ensuring at least **50%** of the remaining passenger-facing SUP items are made with recycled plastics. Working towards the goals, we introduced a **first-of-its-kind recycling workflow** for plastic bottles and cans at Hong Kong International Airport. Internally, we also introduced the first **Reverse Vending Machine** with miles redemption.

OUR PEOPLE

Cathay has a global workforce of more than **30,000** people, with around **7,000** new employees in 2024. To be an employer of choice, we updated our travel policy to allow all eligible employees to nominate a **"Plus One" travel companion** regardless of marital status.
